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Professor Dinwoodie joined the Chicago-Kent faculty in 2000, and previously taught at the University of Cincinnati College of Law and the University of Pennsylvania School of Law. He was appointed to the Chair in Intellectual Property at Queen Mary in 2005. Prior to teaching, Professor Dinwoodie had been an associate with Sullivan and Cromwell in New York. Professor Dinwoodie holds a First Class Honors LL.B. degree from the University of Glasgow, an LL.M. from Harvard Law School, and a J.S.D. from Columbia Law School. He was the Burton Fellow in residence at Columbia Law School for 1988-89, working in the field of intellectual property law, and a John F. Kennedy Scholar at Harvard Law School for 1987-88.
